Commissioner Doug Fuller and Roy Townsend, Managing Director, attended the A2Y Regional Chamber meeting on October 13th.

Commissioner Doug Fuller reported that there is an open lawsuit between a number of aggrieved counties and the Michigan County Road Commission Self-Insurance Pool (MCRCSIP). Commissioner Fuller stated that when Ingham County first withdrew from having a County Road Commission, they were by a matter of law prohibited from receiving insurance from the MCRCSIP. Ingham County filed suit against the MCRCSIP sking for a refund during the period they were part of the MCRCSIP pool. Commissioner Fuller stated that Jackson County was in the same position and joined this lawsual. The Mariet Courts determined in favor of the MCRCSIP but last week the Appellate Court is such a ruling reversing the District Court ruling. Commissioner Fuller stated that this nawsual will be mediatored.

- Shield Road Bridge Cadillac Asphalt should have the roadway resurfacing completed by the end of this week.
