**C. Permits**

Staff received 46 new right-of-way permit applications and 30 plans during this period for review. At this time there are 251 pending right-of-way permits (applied for but not issued); 58 residential, 85 commercial, 85 utility, and 23 miscellaneous permits. Currently there are 779 active right-of-way permits (issued & awaiting completion); 338 residential, 44 commercial, 325 utility, and 72 miscellaneous permits. Staff issued 24 residential and one commercial driveway permits, 15 utility permits, 4 miscellaneous permit, and 80 transportation permits and receipted approximately \$29,285 in permit fees and surety during this period.
