



Zeeb Road Improvement Project

Project Overview

During this project the Washtenaw County Road Commission (WCRC) and its contractor will:

- Rebuild and pave Zeeb Road from Ellsworth Road to Waters Road in Lodi Township
- Pulverize and resurface pavement on Zeeb Road from Waters Road to the StoneCo driveway
- Install curb and gutter and drainage structures
- Install signage and pavement markings

Project Timeline

The contractor will begin construction the week of April 15, 2019. WCRC's goal is to complete the project by mid-August, weather pending.

Starting April 29 (weather pending), 2019, Zeeb Road will be closed to roadway users who do not live or own property in the project limits and a detour will be posted.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How is this project funded?

A: Funding for this project is coming from the following sources:

| Funding Source | Zeeb Road Improvements |

Q: What is the estimated cost of construction for the project?

A: \$1.41 million

Q: What are the limits of construction?

A: Road reconstruction will impact Zeeb Road from Ellsworth Road to the StoneCo Driveway approximately 2,000 feet north of Waters Road.

Q: When will construction begin/be completed?

A: Construction is expected to begin the week of April 15, 2019. WCRC's goal is to complete the project by mid-August, weather pending.

Starting April 29, 2019, Zeeb Road will be closed to roadway users who do not live or own property in the project limits and a detour will be posted.

Q: Will I have access to my property during construction?

A: Yes. All individuals with property inside the construction area (Zeeb Road from Ellsworth Road to Waters Road) will be provided access to and from their property by the contractor during construction.

Q: Will Zeeb Road be open to thru traffic during construction?

A: No. When construction work begins in Mid- April of 2019, Zeeb Road from Ellsworth Road to Waters Road will only be open to property owners and tenants. People who do not live or own property internal to the project limits will be required to follow posted detour routes or seek an alternate route while work is occurring.

Q: Will the intersections of Zeeb Road at Ellsworth Road and Zeeb Road at Waters Road be open to traffic during construction?

A: No, both intersections will be closed to through-traffic for the duration of the project. People who do not live or own property internal to the project limits will be required to follow posted detour routes or seek an alternate route while work is occurring.

For property owners and tenants, who live or work within the project area, WCRC anticipates that each intersection will be closed to all traffic for up to two weeks to allow the contractor to construct the intersection. WCRC will issue a road advisory before the full closure of each intersection.

Q: Will area utilities be affected?

A: No. Relocation of known utilities have already been completed.

Q: What will happen with mail delivery and trash pickup?

A: Mail delivery and garbage collection for residents and property owners who live within the project limits shall be maintained throughout the duration of the project.

Q: Will my lawn be restored once construction is completed?

A: Yes, the contractor will be responsible to grow grass wherever the ground has been disturbed as part of the project.
