



Saline-Milan Road Improvements

Project Overview

During this project the Washtenaw County Road Commission (WCRC) and its contractor will:

- Pulverize and resurface Saline-Milan Road from Judd Road to Willis Road
- Replace the bridge over Koch Warner Drain
- Construct retaining walls on either side of the bridge
- Reconstruct road approaches to the bridge
- Install signage, replace guardrail and install pavement markings

Project Timeline

Road construction will begin on Monday, June 24, 2019. Bridge construction will take place after the road paving has been completed. WCRC's goal is to complete the road and bridge project by the end of September, weather pending.

Saline-Milan Road will be closed to thru traffic between Judd Road and Willis Road throughout the project. No traffic will be allowed to cross the bridge once that work has started.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How is this project funded?

A: Funding for the bridge project is coming from the following sources:

Funding Source	Saline-Milan Road Bridge Replacement
MDOT Local Agency Program Funds	\$1,317,000
Washtenaw County Road Commission	\$69,260
Total	\$ 1,386,260

The resurfacing project on Saline-Milan Road is funded by the four-year Roads and Non-Motorized Millage passed by Washtenaw County voters in 2016.

Q: What is the estimated cost of construction for the bridge project?

A: \$1.39 million

Q: What are the limits of construction?

A: Prior to the bridge construction, Saline-Milan Road will be pulverized and resurfaced from Judd Road to Willis Road.

The bridge replacement will impact Saline-Road Road from approximately the Saline Fisheries Research Station drive to approximately 370 feet to the south.

Q: When will construction begin/be completed?

A: Construction is expected to begin the week of June 24, 2019. WCRC's goal is to complete both the road and bridge project by the end of September, weather pending.

Q: Will I have access to my property during construction?

A: Yes. Residents and property owners who live or work within the construction area will be provided access to and from their property by the contractor during construction.

However, no traffic will be allowed to cross the bridge once that work has started.

Q: Will Saline-Milan Road be open to thru traffic during construction?

A: No. When construction work begins June 24, 2019, Saline-Milan Road from Judd Road to Willis Road will be closed to thru-traffic. Motorists will be required to follow the posted detour or seek an alternate route.

Property owners and residents who live or work within the project area will be provided access by the contractor, however no traffic will be able to cross the bridge.



Q: Will area utilities be affected?

A: No. Relocation of known utilities have already been completed.

Q: What will happen with mail delivery and trash pickup?

A: Mail delivery and garbage collection for residents and property owners who live within the project limits shall be maintained throughout the duration of the project.

Q: Will my lawn be restored once construction is completed?

A: Yes, the contractor will be responsible to grow grass wherever the ground has been disturbed as part of the project.
