
1. We have this day written Lt Colonel Robert E. Schrepper, Executive Officer, 34th Inf Regt, Mich State Troops, directing him to call on you and complete the arrangements for the use of County Road Trucks for the movement of Mich State Troops, housed in the Ypsilanti Armory, in the event of a mobilization.

2. The direction for this contact comes from the Office of Mr. Ziegler, State Highway Commissioner, which it is understood has already advised you of the proposed plan.

3. Lt Colonel Schrepper has been advised that the number of County Road Commission trucks allocated to the Ypsilanti Units is eight, each vehicle capable of loading twelve men, and that a request for such trucks is to be made only in an actual emergency.
