- The latest Michigan Transportation Funds Receipts is starting to reflect a reduction that we have been expecting due to the COVID-19 situation.
- There will be two new Road Commissioners appointed on May 20th at next County Board of Commissioners meeting. The Road Commission will welcome them and begin the introductory process.
- The County Board approved the ballot language for the county roads and nonmotorized path millage. There will be a meeting next Thursday, May 14th for local elected officials on what the millage plan is and educational tools available for them to share with their residents.

ENGINEERING REPORT

Matt MacDonell, Director of Engineering

- Matt MacDonell provided a review of the Federal and Non-Federal Aid project list.
- <u>Ann Arbor-Saline Road and Wagner</u>. <u>oad</u> concrete paving is taking place today. A signal will also be in taking at t is intersection.
- <u>Chubb Road</u> paving is sched lea to comorrow and Thursday.
- <u>Ellsworth Road</u> paving he : tak in place. The next paving location will be Forest Avenue.
- <u>Carpenter Road betwe</u> <u>Ellsworth Road and Packard Road</u> crews are doing preparation write for bis courfacing project which will begin next week.
- <u>Miller Road a. 1 Wagn</u> <u>r Road roundabout project and Miller Road bridge project</u> -The bids were received through the MDOT bid process. The project bids came in high. The estimate was approximately \$1.8 million dollars. The low bid was Fonson Company at \$2.2. million, roughly a 24% overage. The overage was mainly on the bridge side of this project. Staff is recommending MDOT award this contract to Fonson Company.
- <u>Textile Road/Woodland Drive</u> there will be a virtual Public Information Meeting on May 12th at 10:00 a.m.
- <u>Pontiac Trail at 7 Mile Road Roundabout Project</u> there will be a preconstruction meeting this week. This project is scheduled to start in mid-June.
- <u>Cavanaugh Lake Road Culvert Project</u> this project is scheduled to start construction after July 4th.

Jim Harmon, Director of Operations

- Crews very busy with routine maintenance.
- There has been a lot of work on the annual township agreements.

- Operations Department is estimating a total construction value of \$11.4 million dollars. The total estimated township construction cost for this season is \$3.2 million dollars with the township cost share being \$1.8 million.
- County millage projects
 - <u>8 Mile Road between Pontiac Trail and Tower Road</u> Cadillac Asphalt has completed the resurfacing and the road is reopened.
 - <u>Willis Road between Bunton Road and Rawsonville Road</u> resurfacing is underway, Willis Road remains open to traffic.
 - Lohr Circle in Pittsfield Township is being milled and paved tomorrow.
 - <u>Pleasant Lake Road between Zeeb Road and Ann Arbor-Saline Road</u> milling and paving will take place later this year. The crews are working on drainage improvements.
 - Pontiac Trail from Joy Road to Dixbc on ad this is a longer chip seal project.
- Road Commission Funded Primary ' rojects
 - Six Mile Road from Chubb Read to Pontiac Trail asphalt wedging was completed over the weekend in preparation for seal coating.
 - The Operations Department is working with the Engineering Department that secured an all-season haul oute on Pleasant Lake Road between Zeeb Road and Steinbach Rr ad. The pairing is completed, aggregate shoulders are being placed. The road or pen to traffic
- The Heavy Eculpment City and our Shop participated in equipment orientation on new seal coaling equipment.
- The Dust Control Pr gram is getting underway countywide.
- Stamford Road Project This is a permit project of a failing sanitary sewer. Matt MacDonell, Director of Engineering, stated that we are working with Superior Township under permit. There have been issues with dewatering. The sanitary line is at a deeper depth. A consultant is monitoring this daily waiting for the ground water to recede to make this repair.

Dan Ackerman, Director of Finance & IT

FINANCE REPORT

 Michigan Transportation Funds Receipts (MTF) – the MTF for March compared to last year was down about 10% which is for half a month of when the stay at home order took effect. Dan stated that he fully expects the April MTF to be more than a 10% decrease. We received some revised estimates from the state of Michigan. Dan stated that he disagrees with these estimates because they are only estimating a 1% decrease from the previous year which he feels is overly optimistic. Dan stated that he feels the Road Commission is in a good place on our budget for MTF.

- The 2019 Act 51 Report was submitted on time.
- Dan will be attending a virtual applicant meeting at 2:00 today with representatives from the State of Michigan and FEMA representative to discuss the COVID-19 situation and potential reimbursement by FEM of any COVID-19 related expenses.
