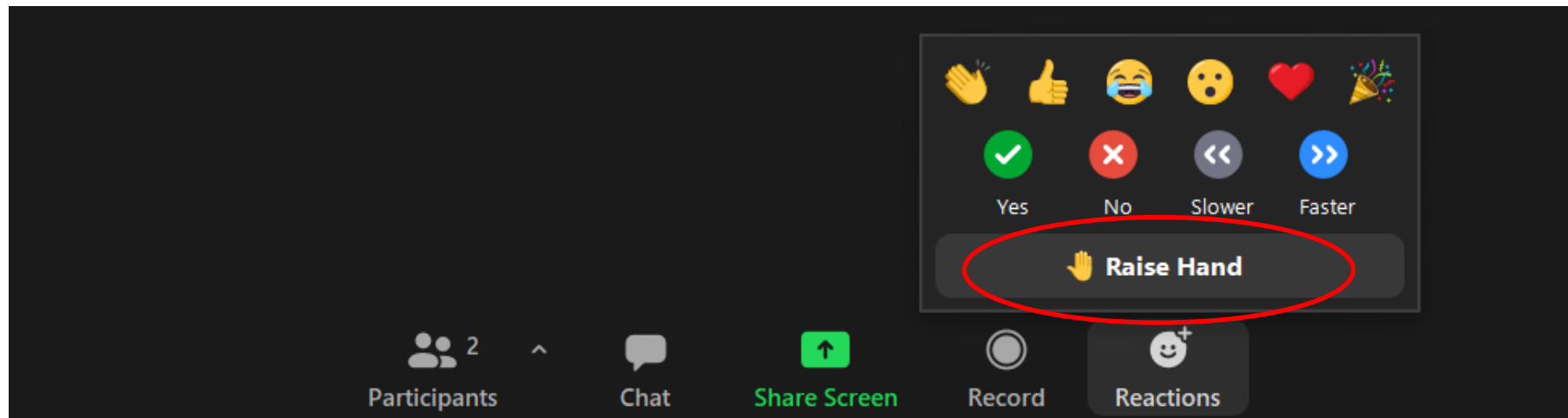

Safety Project: N. Territorial Rd & Webster Church Rd



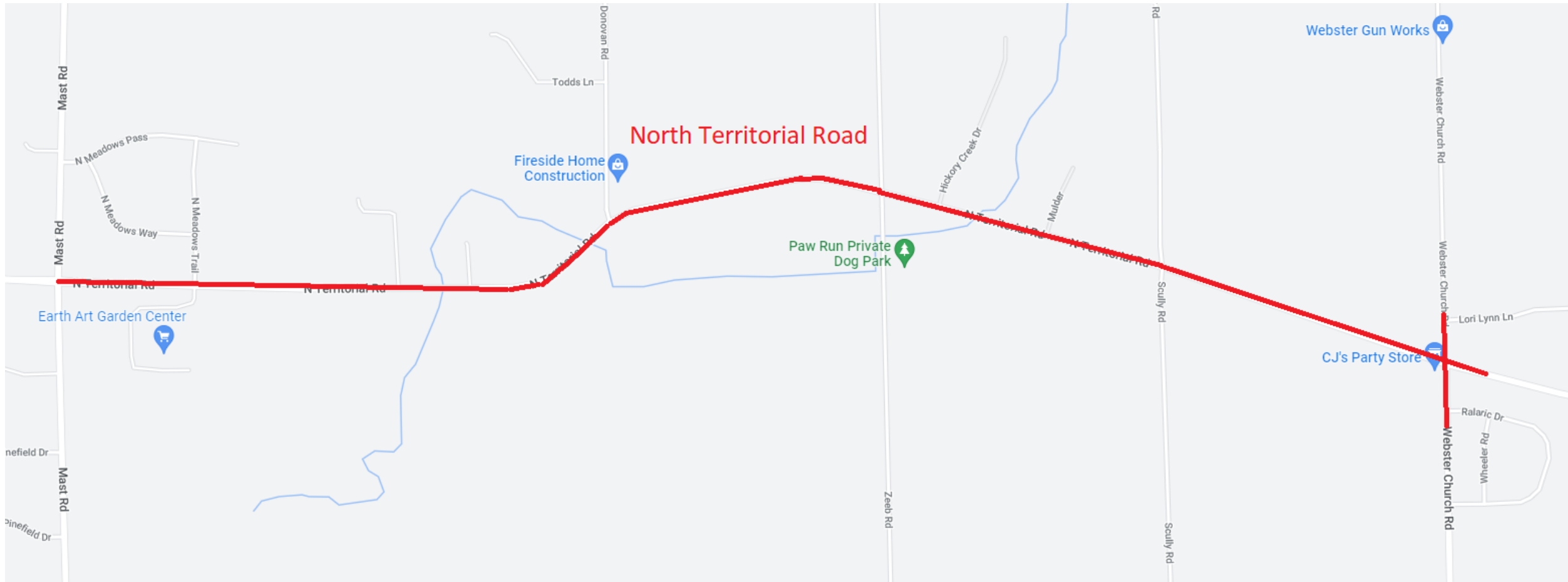
Why?

- Improve the safety and operation of the intersection and the N. Territorial Rd corridor
- Traffic signal with center left turn lanes

Funding

- Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program
- Federal Surface Transportation Program
- Michigan Transportation Funds
- Estimated cost: \$1.4 Million

Project Limits



Project Overview

1. Traffic signal and left turn lanes at the intersection of N. Territorial Rd at Webster Church Rd
2. Culvert replacements on N. Territorial Rd between Meadows Tr & Donovan Rd
3. Centerline rumble strips, pavement markings and signs

Existing Condition



The Plan - intersection improvements

- Widen the road to install center left turn lanes
- Install traffic signal
- Tree removals



Schedule

- Tree removal prior to March 31, 2023
- Intersection work to begin late summer of 2023
- Open to traffic scheduled for fall of 2023

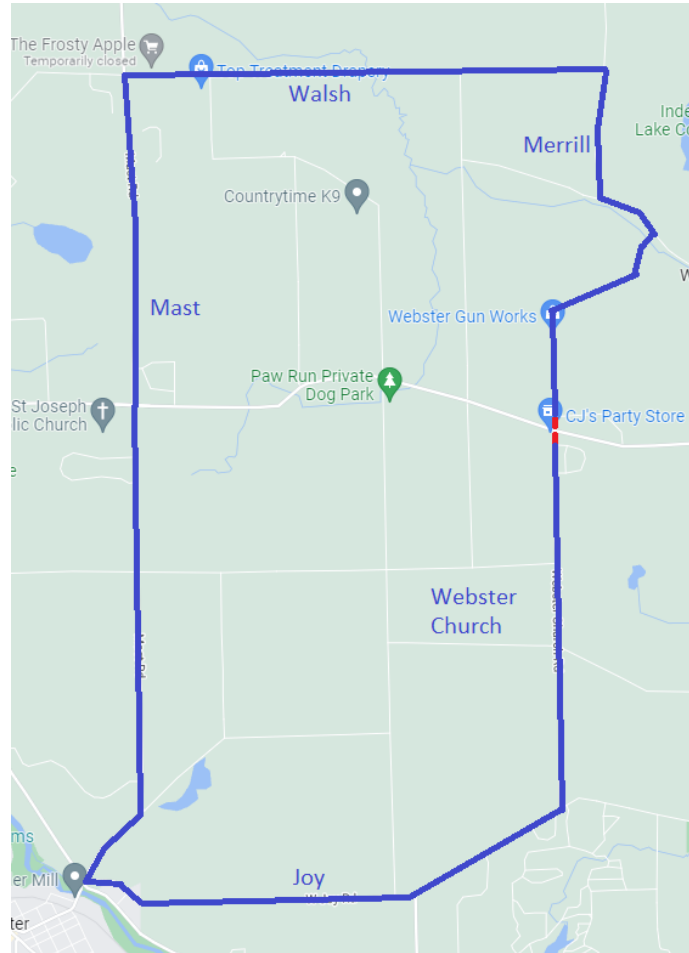


Traffic Impact

- Webster Church Rd will be closed to ALL traffic, north and south of the intersection and a detour will be posted
- Traffic will be maintained on N. Territorial using temporary traffic signals
- Access to CJ's Party Store will be provided via N. Territorial Road

The Plan – culvert replacements



- Maintain two-way traffic using one lane with flagging operation
- Schedule
 - Summer 2023

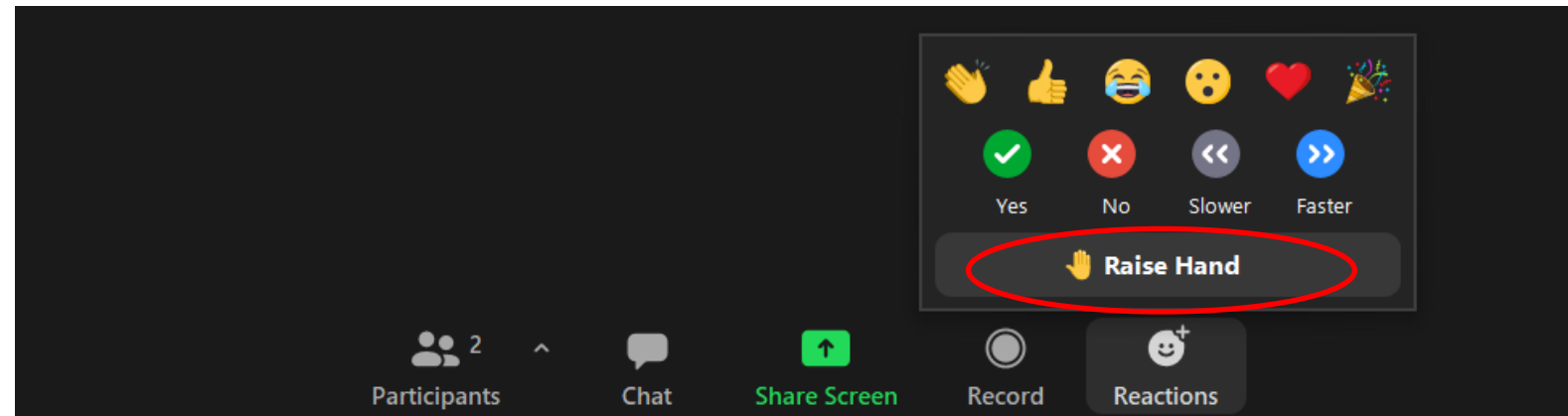
