WIDTH LENGTH

Truck tractor and 2 semitrailers, or truck tractor, semitrailer, and trailer combinations: no overall length limit, if the length of each semitrailer or trailer does not exceed 28-1/2 feet each, or the overall length of the semitrailer and trailer, or 2 semitrailers as measured from the front of the first towed unit to the rear of the second towed unit while the units are coupled together does not exceed 58 feet.

Maximum semi-trailer length of 53 feet, including load, when operating a truck tractor and semi-trailer combination. Semi-trailers longer than 50 feet are limited to three axles and shall be 37.5 feet to 40.5 feet plus or minus 0.5 feet, measured from kingpin coupling to a single axle or to the center of the tandem assembly.

For a truck and trailer or semi-trailer designed and used to transport saw logs, pulpwood, and tree length poles the overall length shall not exceed 70 feet including load.

In compliance with federal requirements, motor vehicles wholly or partially assembled transported by utilizing one (1) tow bar or three (3) saddle mounts with full mount mechanisms and using the motive power of one (1) vehicle shall not exceed a total length of 75 feet.

Vehicles or the loads thereon which exceed the legal dimensions or weights as listed require a Special Transportation Permits are issued only for the occasional movement of oversize or overweight vehicles or loads which cannot be dismantled, reduced, or otherwise rearranged to come within the legal limits.

Beginning January 3, 2018, all transportation permit applications must be submitted via www.oxcartpermits.com and WCRC will no longer process applications using the previous application forms. Companies will need to register for a free account with Oxcart.
