

2025 SALEM TOWNSHIP AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 17 day of June, 2025, by and between the Township Board of Salem Township ("Salem Township"), Washtenaw County, and the Board of Washtenaw County Road Commissioners ("WCRC").

WHEREAS, Salem Township desires that certain improvements be made upon the local roads in the Township of Salem, and

WHEREAS, proper authority is provided to the parties of the agreement under the provisions in Act 51 of Public Acts of 1951 as amended,

IT IS NOW THEREFORE AGREED, the WCRC will accomplish the improvements as specified herein, all in accordance with the standards of the Board of Washtenaw County Road Commissioners,

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, Salem Township shall pay WCRC for the actual project costs incurred for the project; and

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, the WCRC will submit an invoice to the Township on July 1, 2025, for 50% of the estimated project costs. Following project completion and final accounting of the project costs, WCRC will submit the final invoice for the actual remaining unpaid costs. The final invoice shall provide supporting detail and information, which reasonably identifies the actual project costs incurred by WCRC. The Township agrees to remit payment within 30 days from receipt of WCRC invoices.

Currie Road, Five Mile Road to Six Mile Road

Work to include drainage improvements and heavy brushing with associated project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 16,000.00

Five Mile Road, Pontiac Trail Road Easterly 500' feet

Work to include drainage improvements with associated project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 34,000.00

Currie Road, Pleasant View to Wellington

Work to include drainage improvements and heavy brushing with associated project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 17,000.00

Five Mile Road, Currie Road to Curtis Road

Work to include drainage improvements and heavy brushing with associated project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 45,000.00

2025 Salem Township Agreement

Salem Road, End of Pavement to Five Mile Road

Work to include drainage improvements, forestry, heavy brushing, shaping the existing surface, and the application of 6" of 23A Limestone (C.I.P.) (approximately 3,700 tons) with associated dust control and project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 144,000.00

Salem Road, Five Mile Road to Brookville Road

Work to include drainage improvements, forestry, heavy brushing, shaping the existing surface, and the application of 6" of 23A Limestone (C.I.P.) (approximately 4,700 tons) with associated dust control and project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 184,000.00

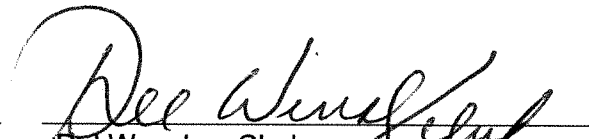
