

## 2026 WEBSTER TOWNSHIP AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 21 day of April, 2026, by and between the Township Board of Webster Township ("Webster Township"), Washtenaw County, and the Board of Washtenaw County Road Commissioners ("WCRC").

WHEREAS, Webster Township desires that certain improvements be made upon the local roads in the Township of Webster, and

WHEREAS, proper authority is provided to the parties of the agreement under the provisions in Act 51 of Public Acts of 1951 as amended,

IT IS NOW THEREFORE AGREED, the WCRC will accomplish the improvements as specified herein, all in accordance with the standards of the Board of Washtenaw County Road Commissioners,

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, Webster Township shall pay WCRC for the actual project costs incurred for the project and any cost savings realized from this agreement may be allocated toward a subsequent agreement; and

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, the WCRC will submit an invoice to the Township on July 1, 2026, for 50% of the estimated project costs. Following project completion and final accounting of the project costs, WCRC will submit the final invoice for the actual remaining unpaid costs. The final invoice shall provide supporting detail and information, which reasonably identifies the actual project costs incurred by WCRC. The Township agrees to remit payment within 30 days from receipt of WCRC invoices.

### **Chamberlin Road, Huron River Drive to North Territorial Road (1.53 Miles)**

Work to include drainage improvements, forestry, heavy brushing, shaping the existing surface, and the application of 6" of 23A Limestone (C.I.P.) (approximately 4,500 tons) with associated dust control and project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 157,000.00

### **Zeeb Road, Merkel Road to North Territorial Road (1.04 Miles)**

Work to include drainage improvements, forestry, heavy brushing shaping the existing surface, and the application of 6" of 23A Limestone (C.I.P.) (approximately 3,000 tons) with associated dust control and project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 112,000.00

### **South Hamburg Road, Barker Road to County Line (.51 Miles)**

Work to include drainage improvements, forestry, heavy brushing, shaping the existing surface, and the application of 6" of 23A Limestone (C.I.P.) (approximately 1,700 tons) with associated dust control and project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 58,000.00

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**Yankee Lane, Danell Dr, Pine Tree Lane and Sunrise Dr. (0.48 Miles)**

Work to include drainage improvements, forestry, shaping the existing surface, and the application of 5" of 22A Gravel (C.I.P.) (approximately 1,400 tons) with associated dust control and project restoration.

Estimated project cost: \$ 77,000.00

**Gregory Road, Huron River Drive to Cobble Lane and Cobble Lane (2.58 Miles)**

Work to include drainage improvements, forestry, heavy brushing shaping the existing surface, and the application of 6" of 23A Limestone (C.I.P.) (approximately 9,100 tons) with associated dust control and project restoration. Project work will begin at Huron River Drive and progress easterly toward Cobble Lane, or until available funds are exhausted. 2026 Township Local Road Program project savings will provide additional funding for this project. Amendments to this agreement will be made to capture residual funds. If necessary, future road improvement projects will complete the segment.




